Empowerment and self love have been the driving force for D. Anne Browne since she began her writing career in 1979. It was during that year she began to spread the gospel of health and fitness to the African American community. It was through a series of books titled, "For The Health of It." By the mid 1980's she began to notice how the literature of the time lacked an analytical approach to the universality of self development. In response to the needs of the African American community, D. Anne began to focus on marketing and her writing on the concepts of self education.

In the early 1990's her first literary attempt was to provide "empowering" material that did not endorse a morbid fascination with the suffering of others as a precursor to developing. Having already realized her dreams of becoming a professional writer, commercial artist, computer programmer, and therapist assistant, D. Anne added "published her first book (*You Can Get There From Here: Life Lessons For The Black Woman*), was published in 1995. Her work, "That Old Black Magic: Essays, Images and Black Men" in 1997.
