

Skillstreaming is a technique for teaching interpersonal, aggression management and other prosocial skills to children.

Specifically, Skillstreaming teaches children:

- How to enhance their relationships with others;
- How to appropriately handle situations that cause stress and unhappiness; and,
- How to solve problems in their daily lives.

Strategies

Strategies used to teach Prosocial Skills include the following:

- Modeling
- Role Playing
- O Providing feedback
- Transfering skills to real life situations
